Newcomers to Canada can access settlement services in many urban and rural communities across Alberta. These organizations offer various services like orientation, mentorship, employment, career consulting, interpretation, counselling, citizenship information, and language assessments. However, not all organizations provide all services.

Language assessment centres provide authorized referrals to governmentfunded language training (LINC), placement testing, and nationally recognized proficiency testing. You can use this tip sheet to locate agencies and organizations serving Alberta communities.
