Category of terminology	Acronym	Definition
Assessment	CELBAN	Canadian Language Benchmarks Assessment for Nurses. A CLB (Canadian Language Benchmarks) language assessment developed specifically for nurses, required by nursing professional bodies. CELBAN
	CELPIP	Canadian English Language Proficiency Index Program. A computer-delivered, CLB-based test used for immigration, citizenship, and admission to educational institutions in Canada.  CELPIP
	CLB	Canadian Language Benchmarks. A national, 12-level descriptive scale of language ability in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Used for planning instruction, curricula, and assessment.  CLB
	CLBPT	Canadian Language Benchmarks Placement Test. An assessment instrument used by CLB-approved assessment centres.
	IELTS	International English Language Testing
	TOEFL	System (UK) & Test of English as a Foreign Language (USA). The two internationally recognized tests are accepted as proof of language competency by educational institutions

		and for immigration and citizenship purposes. Both were originally developed to assess the language proficiency of international students wishing to enter their respective universities. IELTS TESL
Program	EAL	English as an Additional Language. A term used interchangeably with ESL. For many immigrants to Canada, English is not a second language, but rather a third or even fourth. EAL was the term devised to better reflect the learners.
	EAP	English for Academic Purposes. Refers to language training focusing on the language skills required for success in English-speaking academic contexts.
	EFL	<b>English as a Foreign Language.</b> English language training or learning that occurs in non-English speaking settings.
	ELL	English Language Learner. A term used interchangeably with ESL. As with EAL, a new terminology was needed since many immigrants coming to Canada are multilingual.
	ESL	English as a Second Language. A general term used to refer to English language training or learning that occurs in English-speaking settings.
	ESP	English for Specific Purposes. English language training or learning for specific purposes (e.g., English for Engineers).
	EWP	<b>English in the Workplace.</b> English language training or learning that is

		specific to, and often occurs in a particular workplace.
	LINC	Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada. Free language training for adult permanent residents funded by the federal government. Govt. of Canada - LINC
Organization	ATESL	Alberta Teachers of English as a Second Language. A professional organization for teachers and programs providing ESL services for adult ESL learners in Alberta. ATESL
	CALP	Community Adult Learning Program.  Provincially funded organization offering community-based non-profit adult education programs, including classroom-based ESL programming.  CALP
	CLN	Community Learning Network. A provincial non-profit association that supports CALPs (Community Adult Learning Program) by providing resources and training. CALP
	TESL Canada	<b>Teachers of English as a Second Language.</b> Canada's national federation of English as a Second Language teachers, learners, and learner advocates. <u>TESL</u>
